The Level-2 course consists of a workshop with lectures and laparoscopic surgery on human cadavers. The lectures explain the required anatomical and surgical knowledge and further review the lessons acquired during ISoN Certification Level 1 (see www.possover-neuropelveology.com) regarding the diagnosis in neuropelveology. This course teaches laparoscopic techniques for exposing the pelvic nerves and plexus. It provides the necessary knowledge for surgical expertise in "nerve-sparing" pelvic surgery and various laparoscopic neurosurgery techniques for the pelvic nerves, including the implantation of stimulation electrodes – the LION procedures. The course also covers techniques for pelvic nerve infiltration, which are crucial for the diagnostic process in neuropelveology and some therapeutic treatments as well.


